

2022 T.I.P. CHAMPIONSHIPS HARDSHIP REQUEST & DECLARATION FORM

Only use this form if you are not able to automatically qualify for the T.I.P. Championships.

Eligibility: For purposes of eligibility, a "Thoroughbred" is defined as any horse that has been registered with The Jockey Club (TJC) or a foreign Thoroughbred stud book recognized by TJC. Hardship Requests to qualify for Championships will be considered ONLY for Thoroughbreds that are being shown during the Championship year (August 1, 2021, to August 31, 2022), but were not able to attend a show with T.I.P. Awards and did not participate in the 2021 Performance Awards. A Thoroughbred must attend a MINIMUM of two (2) shows during the Championship year and must have been shown at the height or level being requested at one of those shows in order to be considered for a Hardship Request. All Thoroughbreds must have a T.I.P. Number to qualify. See https://tjctip.com/About/CSI. See website for information.

Instructions:

- 1. Fill out all of the Horse, Owner and Rider information on page 2 of this Form.
- 2. Submit this Form along with:
 - a. A statement explaining in less than 500 words why you are not able to access shows with T.I.P. awards to qualify for the Championships, and
 - b. A brief show record covering the Championship year, including show name, date, division, height jumped and any other relevant information. MINIMUM OF TWO SHOWS REQUIRED.

Notification: You will be notified if your Hardship Qualification has been accepted prior to the entry deadline. Incomplete forms will not be accepted.
