KENTUCKY SCHEDULE

- **Arrival:** Horses may not arrive earlier than 12:00 PM on Monday, October 10 and must vacate their stalls by 8:00 AM on Monday, October 17. Makeover-entered horses will follow the Makeover move-in schedule.
- **Check In (Monday):** Barrel racing competitors (only) may pick up their entry packets and numbers on Monday at the RRP show office.
- **Check In (after Monday):** All competitors should pick up their entry packets and numbers at the T.I.P. show office at the T.I.P. booth during the show office times. All competitors must have signed waivers on file to pick up numbers.
