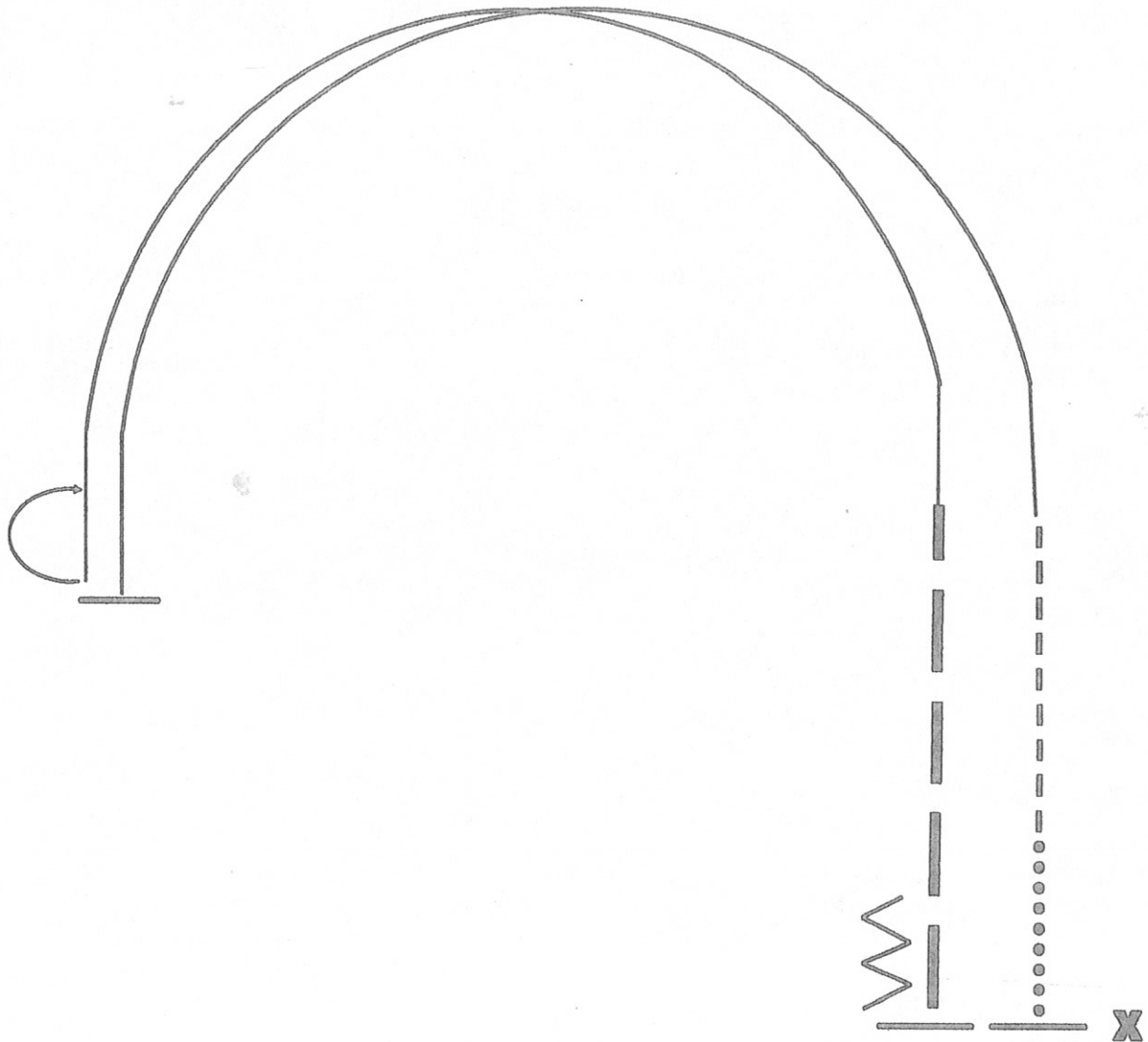




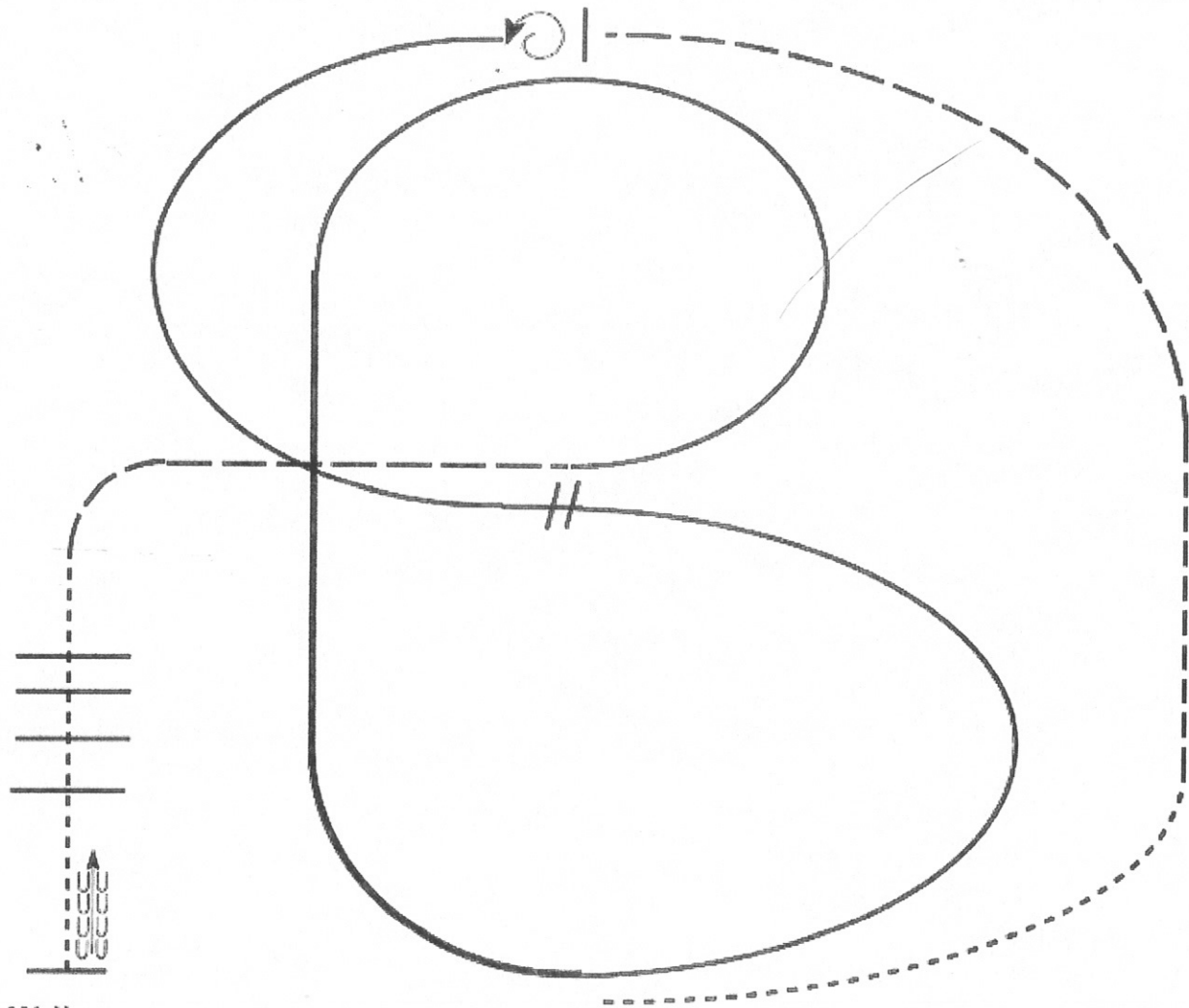
Class 7003: Western Horsemanship

Pattern provided by: Bartley & White



1. From marker walk 2 horse lengths and then jog to center of right wall
2. Lope left lead large half circle
3. Stop and perform a 180 turn right
4. Lope right lead half circle
5. Break to extended trot until even with marker
6. Stop and back 4 steps
7. Return to lineup

1. Walk
2. Trot
3. Extend the trot, at the top of the arena, stop
4. 360 degree turn to the left
5. Left lead 1/2 circle, lope to the center
6. Change leads (simple or flying)
7. Right lead 1/2 circle
8. Extended lope up the long side of arena (right lead)
9. Collect back to a lope around the top of the arena and back to center
10. Break down to an extended trot
11. Walk over poles.
12. Stop and back

Building & Judges

4) Pick up the Jog/Trot to & Over the Natural Poles

3) Continue at The walk, to & over the Bridge

2) Walk to Mailbox, Open Mailbox & Pull Item out, Replace Item & Close mailbox

1) Work Gate: Open, move Through & close

5) Continue the Jog/Trot to the 4 Markers, Maneuver Around the 4 Markers in A Serpentine Pattern

6) After Passing the Forth Marker, pick up the Right Lead to the Barrel

7) Stop at the Barrel, Pick Up the Item & Walk around the Barrel. Then Replace the Item.

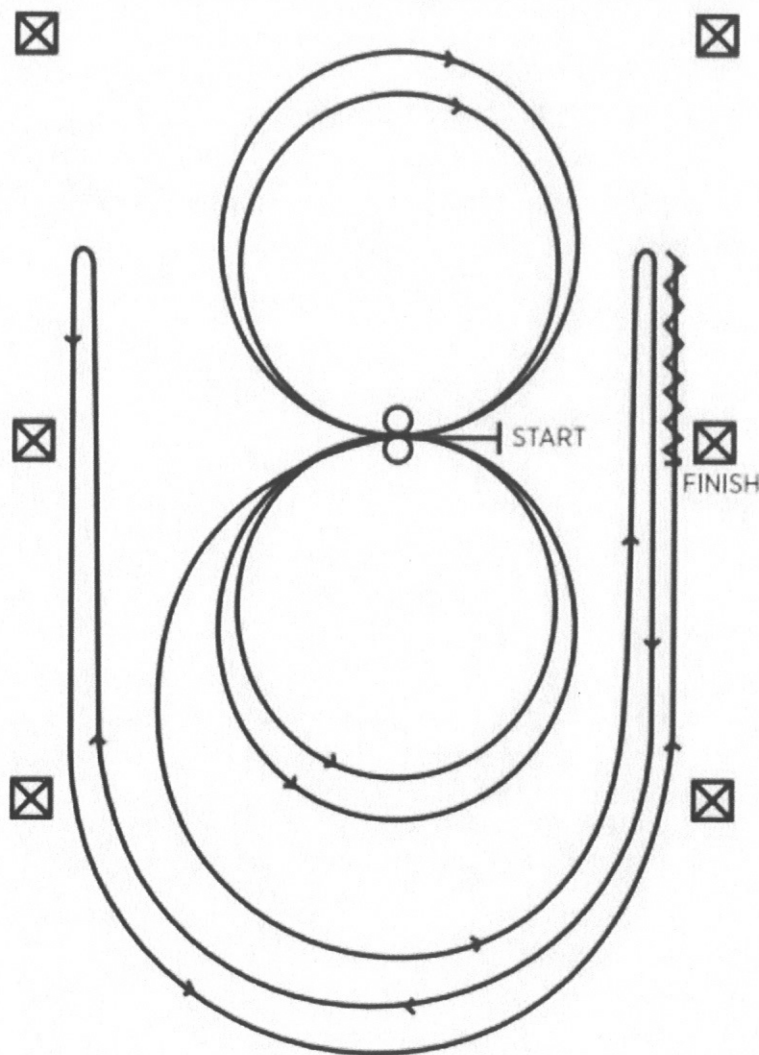
8) Continue the Walk into The chute, Stop & Hesitate. Then back out of the Chute. Upon leaving the chute Make 1/4 Turn, & Exit

Class 7014:

Ranch Reining

Exhibitors may walk or trot their horses to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop before starting the pattern. Begin at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Complete one spin to the right. Hesitate.
2. Complete one spin to the left. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the left lead, complete two circles to the left, with the first circle large and fast, and the second circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
4. Complete two circles to the right, with the first circle large and fast, and the second circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
5. Begin a large fast circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence – no hesitation.
6. Continue back around the previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence – no hesitation.
7. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least 10 feet (3 meters). Hesitate to demonstrate that you have completed the pattern.



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
